Directions

Facility is located at 140 Gabbard Lane, Powells Point, NC 27966

Travel Rt 168 South from VA towards Outer Banks of NC. Rt 168 becomes Rt 158 in 18.5 miles from VA/NC line (Frog Island). Travel through Grandy (Hardees on Left). In approximately 12 miles from Grandy, turn Left on North Spot Rd (just past Island Tattoo billboard). Drive 1.2 miles, turn Left on Gabbard Lane. Follow paved road around to the left to 4-H Center entrance. Watch for SEAT signs. If you miss North Spot Rd, in just under 1 mile, turn Left on South Spot Rd (Powells Point Baptist Church on corner). In 0.8 miles, turn Left on North Spot Rd; then in 0.3 miles, turn Right on Gabbard Lane.
